## Jurilinguistics III

After the successful past editions in 2016 and 2018, which gathered over 120 speakers from 23 different countries, the conference Jurilinguistics III: Interdisciplinary Approaches to the Study of Language and Law, aims to further bridge the gap between professionals and researchers from legal and linguistic fields and to increase mutual understanding.

Due to the Corona crisis, the conference has been postponed until April 2021. It will be held on either **April 7–9 or 14–16, 2021** at the University of Cambridge, the date is yet to be confirmed.

The Call for Papers has been reopened and further submissions are now accepted until September 15.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Summer School for European Legal Linguistics CSS-ERL 2

The Summer School 2020 will focus on the EU legislative process. An EU legislative procedure will be simulated on the basis of a current proposal for a directive of the European Parliament and the Council (the proposed return directive, COM/2018/634 final). The participating students will study the legal and linguistic aspects of such a procedure and will obtain insights into the relationship of law and linguistics.

The planned attendance phase has been scheduled for the period from September 10–16, 2020 and will take place not only in Cologne but also in Brussels, provided that the current situation allows it. Before this phase, students will work in groups via videoconferencing to study different parts of the legislative procedure.

Students from other European countries are explicitly encouraged to participate. This would increase the diversity of the programme and foster more meaningful, pluralistic intellectual exchange. The costs incurred in the course of the program are also covered for international students (with the exception of independent travel expenses to Cologne and back home).

The organizers hope that the Summer School can take place as planned despite the current exceptional situation, however, the attendance phase could be postponed if necessary and required by the authorities.

Students can apply for the Summer School with immediate effect. The application deadline is
